Youth Baseball Tournament Rules

- 1. All games will be scheduled for six innings. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 40 minutes. Extra innings will be played if necessary and time allows.
- 2. 15 run rule after three innings, and 10 run rule after four innings.
- 3. 12 & Under 48' mound 70' bases 10 & Under 46' mound 60' bases
- 4. The extra hitter (EH) is in effect for this tournament. Teams play the field with nine players and may bat ten players if they choose.
- 5. Teams must have eight players to start game. The ninth batting spot will be an out when up. A team choosing not to use an EH will not be assessed an out following the ninth batter
- 6. Dropped third strike:
 - 12 & Under Batter MAY run on a dropped third strike.10 & Under Batter may NOT run on a dropped third
 - strike. Home is closed in U10 division.
- 7. Runners may leave base once ball crosses home plate. Runner will be called out if he leaves early.
- 8. No Re-entry Once a player is removed from the game, he is out for the remainder of the game. Exception: If an active player sustains any injury that requires him to leave the game and his team has used all of its available substitute players, the coach may substitute for the injured player with the first player who was removed from the game.
- 9. Pitchers may throw three innings per game, six innings per day, and ten innings for the tournament. A Game Summary form (score, pitchers used and umpire signatures) will be kept of each game by the home plate umpire and recorded with tournament officials.
 - i. Six warm up pitches between innings
 - ii. One pitch will constitute a full inning pitched
- 10. Once a pitcher is relieved, he may not return to the mound during that game.

- 11. There will be no balks called.
- 12. Any runner is out when the runner does not slide or attempt to get around a fielder who has the ball and is waiting to make the tag.
- 13. Courtesy runners are encouraged for catchers with two outs. Courtesy runners may be any player who is not currently in the game and will not count as an entry into the game.
- 14. Maximum bat diameter: 2-1/4" and -10 to -12 **OR** have USA baseball stamp.
- 15. Players can compete on only one team.


Tie Breakers

In the event of a tie within pool play, the following tie breaker formula will be used to determine standings:

- 1. Head to head competition.
- 2. Fewest runs allowed.
- 3. Most amount of runs scored.
- 4. Coin flip.

Additional Requests & Info

- 1. The "home" team is responsible for keeping the "official" book. The "home" team is determined with a coin toss prior to game.
- 2. Please have players hustle on and off the field.
- 3. Please have your team clean the dugout after each game.
- 4. Our umpires are volunteers, so respect their efforts. Coaches are responsible for parent and fan behavior.
- 5. Unsportsmanlike conduct is subject to ejection from the game and/or tournament upon the umpire's discretion.
